Title I

All Title I documents are available in a binder located in the front office. This binder includes the School Improvement Plan (SIP), the Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP), School-Home Compact, SAC Minutes, Title I Brochure, and the SPAR report. Documents will also be available on the school website.

Dear Hamilton Families, Did you know that absenteeism during the first month of school can predict poor attendance throughout the school year. Poor attendance can influence whether a child can read proficiently by the end of 3rd grade or be held back. By 6th grade chronic absenteeism is the leading indicator of whether a student will drop out from high school. Below is a list of what constitutes an excused absence. Please be sure to communicate with your students' teachers regarding any and all absences. **What counts as an excused absence:** personal illness of the student with a doctor's note (any absence in which the student is

student with a doctor's note (any absence in which the student is out 5 or more consecutive days requires medical documentation to be excused), court appearance of the student, medical appointment of the student with a doctor's note, approved school activity, extreme weather, other absences with prior approval of the principal or designee, attendance at a center under Children and Families Services supervision, significant community events with prior permission of the principal, religious instruction or religious holiday, death in the immediate family, appointments for a therapy service provided by a licensed health care practitioner.
