#### What Makes Us Special

- Students "think like engineers" as they work through the Engineering Design Process as implemented through specialized engineering curriculum units of study.
- A blended technology model is used to instruct and enhance learning in our Robotics Center, Innovator's Design Lab and Discovery Hub Learning Spaces.

#### Technology and the Future



- Students are introduced to the newest technologies and activities designed to build their problem solving, logical thinking, and collaboration skills.
- We integrate engineering and technology into language arts, mathematics and science standards, making meaningful connections for learning.
- Computer Science 2020 Our students participate in at least 10 hours of computer science learning each school year.

#### Student Achievement

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady
  progress monitoring. 57% of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and 56% of K5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **38%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.
